How does our common culture generally think a person gets to heaven/is saved? Is this any different from the perception of the young man in the passage?

Why does the young man think he needs to do some "good deeds" to be sure of eternal life?

Was the young man being genuine in his statements to Jesus that he had kept the law?

Why does the man still think he lacks something to be sure of entering heaven? What does this say about people and their spiritual awareness?

When you think about your own salvation, on what basis do you have any confidence of entering heaven?

Why did Jesus tell the man to sell his possessions and give all to the poor? Does Jesus want us to sell all our possessions and give to the poor as well? Why or why not?

Why do riches make entering heaven/salvation difficult? What do they do to a person?

Are you rich? How does this make you feel about your salvation?

Who needs to hear the truth of this passage, and how will you share it with them?

How can you live differently in light of the truth of this passage?
