**Life Group Questions for the Week of August 22, 2021**

1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you?
  
2. We saw on Sunday that all authority has been given to Jesus, making him the ultimate authority. "Authority" is a word that makes a lot of people uncomfortable, seeing it as an encroachment on our freedom. In what ways is it good that Jesus has all authority?
  
3. When do you know that someone is a disciple of Jesus?
  
4. In Mt. 28:20, Jesus says we're to "teach" others to observe all that he's commanded us. Does this have to do more with learning information or obedience? What does this "teaching" look like?
  
5. Can you think of any people who influenced you on your journey to becoming a follower of Jesus? If so, what influenced you the most?
  
6. When we consider Jesus' command to "make disciples of all nations," it may seem like an overwhelming task. It's helpful not to worry about the entire world but to be concerned about somebody in the world. What can we learn from 1 Corinthians 3:5-9 when it comes to making disciples?
  
7. What are implications of Jesus' promise of, "I am with you always"?
