Life Group Questions for the Week of February 20, 2022

1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you?

3. Have you ever been incarcerated, trapped, held captivated? How did it feel when you were finally freed/liberated?

5. When are you most in danger of living as a slave and not as a son?
6. Read 3:26-28. What are implications of this when it comes to the unity/oneness of God's people in the church?
7. Discuss both the significance of and the relationship between God sending His son (4:4) and Him sending His Spirit into our hearts (4:6).
8. How do you feel about being an adopted son of God? What are the best things about being an heir of God?
9. What have you learned this week that you can share with someone who needs to know Jesus?
