Life Group Questions for the week of February 11, 2018

1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you?

2. If you had lived back during the time of the Old Testament, how would you have benefitted from living under the law?

3. We saw Sunday that one of the purposes of the Law of Moses was to serve as a mirror, helping people see their need for salvation from sin. How does the law clarify the issues of sin?

4. Was Jesus accountable to the Law in his earthly life? Why or why not?

5. Why do people need to know God has laws before they can understand why Jesus' death is good news?

6. How is relating to God through the law like being kept in prison (Galatians 3:23) or being supervised (v. 25)?

7. Read Galatians 4:7. Not only were we bought by Christ but adopted into His family. How should that change the motivation for our behavior?

8. What is the difference between being a son and being a slave? What are some legal implications of adoption and what rights do the adopted children possess?
