Life Group Questions for the week of May 6, 2018

- 1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you?
- 2. Why did (do) the Jews think highly of Moses?
- 3. We are encouraged to "fix your thoughts on Jesus" in Hebrews 3:1. Read Hebrews 12:1-2 and Colossians 3:1. What are some practical ways to put this into practice? What benefits might you experience?
- 4. What does it mean, "We are his house" (3:6)? (also see 1 Corinthians 3:16-17.) Have you considered what part God wants you to play in the further building of his house?
- 5. What does daily encouragement in the faith look like? Why do you think it is important for it to be daily?
- 6. How would it help if everyone was accountable to another? How much accountability to other Christ-followers have you established in your life? Should there be more?
- 7. Compare 3:12-14 to 10:24,25. How do our assemblies relate to our exhorting one another? What can we learn about the importance of attendance?
- 8. How would you describe the connection between unbelief (v. 12 and 19) and disobedience (v. 18)?
- 9. What can you do to encourage fellow believers whose lives are more characterized by anxiety than by the promised rest they have in Christ?
- 10. Who do you know that might need some exhortation this week? What are at least two ways you can encourage them in their faith this week?
