Life Group Questions for the Week of June 3, 2018

- 1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you?
- 2. Summer is just around the corner! Do you have any special plans, activities or prayer requests for the next few months?
- 3. Looking back at this past quarter and year, how has your Growth Group experience helped your walk with Jesus? Can you think of any Growth Group prayers God has answered? (This is our final week of the Spring Quarter. Growth Groups will take a summer break and resume the week of September 16.)
- 4. The purpose of the Law (including the 10 Commandments) has been misunderstood over time and this misunderstanding has been passed on in churches and homes. How does Deuteronomy 6:1-9, 24-25 (which follows immediately after the 10 Commandments written out in Deuteronomy 5) help us better understand how to apply the principles of these commandments in our lives?

Of the benefits that you listed, which one is the hardest for you to grasp and understand? Why? What is the most encouraging of these to you?
- 6. If new covenant believers are not under the Law, how can we know which Old Testament commands apply to us today?
