LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

1. Looking back at your notes from Sunday's message, was there anything that caught your attention, challenged you, or confused you?
2. What is the Gospel? How does it relate to loving your enemies? Can you communicate the Gospel clearly to someone far from God quickly and without notes? What does it mean to love your enemies? What does that look like in your life?

4. Why does Jesus tell us to pray for our enemies and for those that persecute us? What does that accomplish?
5. Why isn't it enough to only love those like us? Why must we love those who are opposed to us?
6. Get personal: Who are your enemies? What can you do to show them love the next time you interact with them?
7. What does Jesus mean by "Be perfect like your heavenly Father is perfect"? How can we be perfect when we struggle daily with sin?
8. Where can we get the power to live the way Jesus wants us to?
