- 5. If the resurrection is essential to Christianity, why do some people call themselves Christians yet deny the resurrection?**
- 6. How has the resurrection impacted your life?**
- 7. Paul lists a whole host of negative consequences if the resurrection isn't true. Which negative consequence disturbs you the most and why?**
- 8. As a group exercise, turn the negative consequences of no resurrection into positive statements resulting from the resurrection. (e.g., "your faith is in vain" becomes "your faith is valid and weighty").**
- 9. Which of those positive statements excites you the most?**
- 10. Who in your life needs to hear the truth of the resurrection? How can you go about sharing with them?**
