7. What keeps people today from being prepared for Christ's return? What are different ways you can help others prepare for it?
8. How should the message of this parable change the way we live and the way we relate to our neighbor, co-worker, family, etc.?
9. What is one thing you can change this week that will better prepare you for Jesus' return?
