Life Group Questions for the Week of May 1, 2022

1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you?

2. What are some ways that our culture depends on or encourages envy?

3. What do people most envy in and/or about others? In what ways does being envious make you miserable?

4. Read James 3:14-16. Where does envy or selfish ambition come from? What kind of misery or trouble can envy or selfish ambition cause a person? Think of someone you know who struggles with envy. What kind of trouble does this create for them?

5. Read 1 Timothy 6:3-11. What does envy arise from? Give an example of a wrong doctrine or teaching that might lead to envy. What doctrines or teachings lead to godliness with contentment?

6. Read Romans 12:15. How does empathy play a part in rejoicing with those who rejoice? How is envy a violation of the command to love our neighbor as yourself?
