**Life Group Questions for the Week of May 14, 2023**

1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

2. Read James 1:19-21. What does it mean to "be quick" with regard to hearing? What are some of the benefits of being "quick to hear?" When do you find yourself having difficulty listening to others?

3. What benefits are ours if we are "slow to speak" (Prov. 10:19; 17:27-28 & Matt. 12:36-37)?

4. What connection do you see between the three commands in v. 19?

5. Is anger prohibited in this verse? What is the difference between getting angry slowly and getting angry quickly?

6. Describe a time when your anger led you in the wrong direction. What resulted from your anger?

7. What's the difference between sinful anger and righteous anger? What does Jesus in Matthew 5:21-26 think of sinful anger? What are its consequences?

8. Read and discuss Ephesians 4:26-27, James 1:19-20, and Mark 3:5.

9. Discuss the differences between relationships characterized by pride versus humility/meekness.
