3. How could "chosen" people come to the point where "they do not know how to do right" (Amos 3:10)?
4. Read Amos 7:7-9 regarding God's plumbline. How do most people decide whether or not they're good people? How can we measure where we are in our walk with God?
5. According to Amos 7:14,15, what was Amos' occupation? When have you felt unqualified to do something for God, but did it anyway? How did you get past the fear?
6. Amos declared God's judgment on several nations throughout his writings. Can a whole country or political system be sinful? How So?
7. What does it mean to "prepare to meet your God" (4:12)? Would this instill fear, joy, apathy or what? Why?
8. What were Amos credentials to be a prophet? Would Amos rather be farming in Judah or in prophesying in Israel? How many ministers are in our group? What credentials (academic, spiritual, other) do you have to be in ministry?
9. Are you yearning for the "Day of the Lord" (Amos 5:18,20)? Why or why not?
10. The Lord says, "Seek me and live" (5:4). How will you do that this week? What spiritual disciplines help you be more "alive" in the Lord?
