- 3. We heard this Sunday that followers of Jesus are dearly loved children. Just like in our earthly family, being a child of God comes with a host of benefits and responsibilities. What encourages you or challenges you in the following passages about the benefits and responsibilities of being a child of God? 1 John 3:1-3, Hebrews 12:7-12, Galatians 4:4-7
