THE PASSAGE: Ephesians 5:3-14 NKJV

<sup>3</sup> **But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you,** as is fitting for saints;

1. Don't go after what \_\_\_\_\_ did not give you.

<sup>4</sup> **neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting,** which are not fitting, but **rather giving of thanks. (Titus 2:11-15)**

<sup>5</sup> For <sup>[a]</sup>this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. <sup>6</sup> **Let no one deceive you** with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience. <sup>7</sup> Therefore do not be partakers with them. (**Gal 5:19-21; 1 Cor 6:9-11**)

2. Deception \_\_\_\_\_ sin.

<sup>8</sup> For **you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light (Col 1:13; Prov 6:23; Rom 13:12; 1 John 1:5-7; John 12:35-36)**

3. We have \_\_\_\_\_ Kingdoms.

<sup>9</sup> (for the **fruit of the <sup>[b]</sup>Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth**), <sup>10</sup> **finding out what is acceptable** to the Lord. (**1 Thess 5:15; Rom 12:1-2; Matt 5:14-16**)

4. Our resurrected lives \_\_\_\_\_ God's will.

<sup>11</sup> And have **no fellowship** with the unfruitful works of darkness, but **rather <sup>[c]</sup>expose them.**

5. It takes resurrected lives and \_\_\_\_\_ to be faithful witnesses.

<sup>12</sup> For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. <sup>13</sup> But all things that are <sup>[d]</sup>exposed are made manifest by the light, for **whatever makes manifest is light. (John 3:18-21)**

6. Light makes everything \_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>14</sup> Therefore He says:

**"Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, And Christ will give you light."**
