The Passage: John 4:31-38

<b>John 4:42 NKJV</b> "Then they said to the woman, "Now we believe, not
because of what you said, for we ourselves have heard <i>Him</i> and we
know that this is indeed [a]the Christ, the Savior of the world."
GOD IS A SAVIOR BY NATURE
1. Christ is the Savior the world has. <b>Is 49:5-6; Jn 8:23-24</b>
WE (GOD"S) PEOPLE MAY HAVE AN ATTITUDE PROBLEM
2. Not like more like Jesus. (Is 42:1-7; Lk 19:10)
SHARING HIS WELCOME WITH OTHERS:
<u>John 4:27-30 NKJV</u> <sup>27</sup> And at this <i>point</i> His disciples came, and they
marveled that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You
seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her?" <sup>28</sup> The woman then <b>left her</b>
waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, <sup>29</sup> "Come, see
a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?"
<sup>30</sup> Then <b>they went out of the city and came to Him</b> .
GOD'S WORK IS SATISFYING.
3. Our true comes from doing God's work. (Matt
4:4; 6:31-33)
John 4:31-34 NKJV <sup>31</sup> In the meantime His disciples urged Him, saying,
"Rabbi, eat." 32 But He said to them, "I have food to eat of which you
do not know." <sup>33</sup> Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has
anyone brought Him <i>anything</i> to eat?" <sup>34</sup> Jesus said to them, " <b>My food is</b>
to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.
HELP WANTED AND NEEDED
<u>John 4:35-38 NKJV</u> <sup>35</sup> Do you not say, 'There are <b>still four months and</b>
then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and
look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! <sup>36</sup> And he
who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both
he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. <sup>37</sup> For in this the
saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.' 38 I sent you to reap that
for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have
entered into their labors."

## 2 Corinthians 5:18-21 NKJV

<sup>18</sup> Now **all things** *are* **of God**, who has **reconciled us** to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has **given us the ministry of reconciliation**, <sup>19</sup> that is, that **God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself**, not <sup>[d]</sup> imputing their trespasses to them, and has **committed to us the word of reconciliation**.

<sup>20</sup> Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. <sup>21</sup> For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
