John 7:1-24

¹ After this Jesus went about in Galilee . He would not go about in Judea, because the Jews^[a] were seeking to kill him. ² Now the Jews' Feast of Booths was at hand . (Jn 5:18)

³ So his brothers ^[b] said to him, "Leave here and go to Judea, that your disciples also may see the works you are doing. ⁴ For no one works in secret if he seeks to be known openly. If you do these things, show yourself to the world." ⁵ For not even his brothers believed in him. ⁶ Jesus said to them, "My time has not yet come, but your time is always here. ⁷ The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify about it that its works are evil. ⁸ You go up to the feast. I am not ^[c] going up to this feast, for my time has not yet fully come." ⁹ After saying this, he remained in Galilee. ¹⁰ But after his brothers had gone up to the feast, then he also went up, not publicly but in private. ¹¹ The Jews were looking for him at the feast, and saying, "Where is he?" ¹² And there was much muttering about him among the people. While some said, "He is a good man," others said, "No, he is leading the people astray." ¹³ Yet for fear of the Jews no one spoke openly of him.

¹⁴ About the middle of the feast Jesus went up into the temple and began teaching . ¹⁵ The Jews therefore marveled, saying, "How is it that this man has learning , ^[d] when he has never studied ?" ¹⁶ So Jesus answered them, " My teaching is not mine , but his who sent me. ¹⁷ If anyone's will is to do God's will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority. (Proverbs 1:20-23)

¹⁸ The one who speaks on his own authority seeks his own glory ; but the one who seeks the glory of him who sent him is true, and in him there is no falsehood. ¹⁹ Has not Moses given you the law ? Yet none of you keeps the law . Why do you seek to kill me? " ²⁰ The crowd answered, "You have a demon! Who is seeking to kill you? " ²¹ Jesus answered them, " I did one work, and you all marvel at it. ²² Moses gave you circumcision (not that it is from Moses, but from the fathers), and you circumcise a man on the Sabbath . ²³ If on the Sabbath a man receives circumcision, so that the law of Moses may not be broken, are you angry with me because on the Sabbath I made a man's whole body well? ²⁴ Do not
