**Life Group Questions for the Week of May 18, 2025**

1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

2. In what way does our society instill in us the desire to be served?

3. Jn 13:1 tells us Passover was at hand and that Jesus knew His hour had come. Why did Jesus die for our sins during the feast of Passover?

4. In light of His impending suffering on the cross, discuss Jesus' thinking/motivation in Jn 13:1-5.

5. Peter objects to what Jesus is doing in Jn 13:6-8. Why does letting someone serve you require humility?

6. What do you think is the significance of what Jesus "knew" in Jn 13:1-3 for him to humbly wash the disciples' feet?

7. Jesus says he gave His followers an example of "washing one another's feet" (Jn 13:14,15) to follow. What does this mean practically? How good are you at "washing others' feet"?

8. Read Lk 22:24. Why is that detail helpful as you consider Jesus' words in Jn 13:14-17?

9. What is one practical thing you can do this week to follow Jesus' example of humble service?
