- Do you have any questions or anything that is unclear after hearing the message Sunday.
- Jesus clearly predicted his death and resurrection many times. So, why weren't the disciples at the tomb early Sunday morning expecting to see a risen Jesus? See the following verses: Matthew 16.21, 17.22-23, 20.17-19; Mark 8.31, Mark 9.30-31; Luke 9.22; John 2.19-22
- Why is saving faith impossible without God's help? Review the following verses: Luke 18.24-26, Romans 3.10-12.
- Why is thinking and reason an essential part of saving faith?
- Why is an emotional experience of Jesus just as necessary as reason for saving faith?
- Why is saving faith different for every person? What does that tell you about God? What does it tell you about people?
- Why did Jesus have to suffer and die? Why is this so hard for people to believe? What does this tell you about humanity and our perspective of ourselves and our needs?
- What are some practical applications of this text for us today? How can the truth of the passage influence how you interact with Jesus and with the world?
