Life Group Questions for the Week of April 12, 2026

Read Luke 24:13–35

1. Looking back at your notes from this Sunday's message, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
2. Why do you think the disciples didn't recognize Jesus at first?
3. Read Luke 24:21 and Isaiah 55:8–9. How can we learn to trust God when His ways don't match ours? What has helped you recognize Jesus walking alongside you when you are down spiritually?
4. What are some ways we might be failing to recognize Jesus in our everyday lives? See Luke 24:16, 2 Corinthians 5:7, and John 14:17.
5. According to Luke 24:31–32, 2 Corinthians 5:17, and Colossians 1:16–17, how does truly recognizing Jesus change the way we see ourselves, our circumstances, and our purpose?
6. Jesus used Scripture to reframe the understanding of those headed to Emmaus. Why is Scripture essential for interpreting our experiences—especially in confusing or painful seasons? See Luke 24:25–27, Psalm 119:105, Romans 15:4, and 2 Timothy 3:16–17.
7. In Luke 24:29, the disciples invited Jesus to stay with them. What insight does James 4:8 give as to what it looks like practically to "invite Jesus in" today? What habits help build a real relationship with Jesus?
